MEMBER BYLAWS

2007

I. PURPOSE – Feel Good Farm is a private, for-profit farm dedicated to the promotion of positive social interaction for its members through agricultural, educational and recreational activities. Families and individuals are invited to become members of Feel Good Farm and participate in the activities alone or in groups. The goal of each activity is to help members have fun and feel good about themselves so that they in turn will contribute in positive ways to our society.

II. MEMBERSHIP – Single, family and group memberships are available on an annual basis. Applications for membership are confidential and will not be disclosed to other members or agencies. Management reserves the right to deny any or all applications. Membership may be revoked by management for cause, determined solely at the discretion of management.

Members may bring guests to the farm upon receiving prior permission from the management. Guests shall be accompanied by a member and may be required to pay an activity fee.

III. ORIENTATION – All new members are required to participate in an orientation to Feel Good Farm. Orientation will familiarize each member with the property and the activities. The orientation may include a safety program and a review of emergency response procedures. Trail and property markings will be reviewed with special attention to respecting abutter's property lines.

IV. MEETINGS – An annual meeting for all members will be held at the farm at a date to be determined. If attendance will be greater than 200 the meeting will be held at an appropriate location offsite. Members are invited to discuss new and old activities and programs. Committees will report to the membership on recommendations and findings which affect the operation of the farm.

V. ACTIVITIES – Participation in any activity requires a reservation. The number of participants in each activity is limited and available on a first come, first serve basis. Members are required to call in advance to reserve space and time for their desired activities.

VI. PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES - Members and guests shall not commit illegal acts on the property. Alcohol shall not be permitted on the property for sale, use or consumption. Guns shall not be permitted on the property except for hunting and hunter safety training. Other weapons (i.e. knives, bow and arrows) are permitted only at scheduled events and at the permission of

- VI.** management. Use of profanity is prohibited. Indecent clothing and behavior is prohibited. In all cases, management shall determine what is unacceptable and prohibited.
- VII. VIOLATIONS** – Any illegal act committed on the property is considered a major violation of the bylaws. Any member who knowingly and willfully commits a major violation to the bylaws is subject to immediate removal from the property and loss of membership, solely at the discretion of management and/or the property owner. Minor violations such as excessive noise or arrival at the property without prior notice will result in a written warning to the responsible member. Three or more written warnings in one calendar year may result in loss of membership to Feel Good Farm, solely at the discretion at management.
- VIII. STANDING AND SPECIAL COMMITTEES** – Committees will be formed at the interest of members. Examples of the committees expected are: Activities Committee, Safety Committee, Volunteers Committee, Garden Committee and Forestry Committee. Management will participate with each committee. Committees will advise the management on all aspects of the farm that relate to their committee. Final decisions are at the discretion of management.
- IX. INDEMNIFICATION** – All members and guests are required to sign an indemnification form prior to participating in activities at the farm.
- X. NOTICES and CALENDAR**– Special events and meetings will be scheduled on the farm calendar. All members will be provided a monthly calendar of events prior to each month. Unscheduled activities such as individual recreation are by appointment only.
- XI. ASSIGNMENTS** - Membership is not assignable without permission from the management.
- XII. AMENDMENTS** – Management may amend the bylaws at any time. Notice of amendments will be mailed to all members and will become effective immediately.
- XIII. MEMBERSHIP AND ACTIVITY FEES** – Members shall be required to pay an annual fee for membership at the Farm. Memberships shall be classed as single, family, youth (under 18), or group. Membership fees shall be established by management and may be revised at the sole discretion of

management. Revised fees will become effective upon renewal of membership or at application for new membership.

- XIV.** Special events and activities may require an additional activity fee at the discretion of management. Membership fees are non-refundable. Activity fees are non-refundable unless the activity or event has been cancelled or postponed.
- XV. NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION -** Members may bring guests to the farm upon receiving prior permission from the management. Guests shall be accompanied by a member and may be required to pay an activity fee. Guests shall be required to sign an Indemnification and General Release form prior to participating in any activity at the Farm. Management reserves the right to deny participation by any non-member in any activity at the Farm.
- XVI. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT –** By signing this form as member or guest, I hereby acknowledge that I have read and understand the bylaws for Feel Good Farm, Inc. and agree to abide by said bylaws.
